ADMINISTRATION OF FASIS

The Fire Agencies Self Insurance System (FASIS) is administered under contract by Sedgwick. Sedgwick's Self-Insurance Pooling Division specializes in the administration and management of public agency joint powers authorities.

As a risk-sharing program, FASIS provides a cost-effective form of workers' compensation coverage unique to the 200 member fire agencies throughout the State of California. In order for a fire district to participate in FASIS, it must be: 1) a public agency permitted to self-insure for workers' compensation; and 2) committed to participating in FASIS for a minimum of three program years.

COVERAGE STRUCTURE

FASIS provides first-dollar coverage, self-insuring the first \$750,000 through a primary and mid-layer risk-sharing pool. The program extends to include coverage above the pool's threshold through the Local Agency Workers' Compensation Excess Joint Powers Authority (LAWCX) and Public Risk Innovation, Solutions and Management (PRISM), to statutory limits.

SAFETY & LOSS CONTROL

Through the Safety & Loss Control Program, many resources are available to assist members in improving their safety and loss control programs and reducing firefighter injuries. Such resources include on-site reviews, pre-placement physicals/annual physicals/fitness for duty, member support, and a variety of other training resources.

MEMBER COMPOSITION & RESPONSIBILITIES

Members must be a fire protection or community services district in the State of California. Prospective members must apply and undergo a thorough underwriting process before receiving final approval from the Board of Directors. Following approval, the member district must:

- Maintain an injury and illness prevention program;
- Promptly pay annual contributions and other monies owed;
- On a timely basis, report job-related accidents or illness to the third-party claims administrator;
- Maintain a three-year commitment as a member; and
- Cooperate with and assist FASIS in all program-related matters as outlined in the Program's governing documents.
